DOMAINES DEVILLARD













BURGUNDY

This is a story which goes back for many centuries. In the 18th century, Château de Chamirey which is still the family house today used to overlook the whole area of Côte Chalonnaise. In 1934, Marquis de Jouennes, father-in-law of Bertrand Devillard, produced his first bottle of red Mercurey. Today, the members of the Devillard family work together to care for 3 estates.

Managed by Bertrand & Christiane Devillard and their children Amaury & Aurore since 1996, **Domaine des Perdrix**, located in Côte de Nuits spreads over 12 hectares in the best terroirs within the villages Nuits-Saint-Georges and Vosne- Romanee. Nearly 5 hectares of the estate produce Nuits Saint Georges Premier Cru, among which the excellent "Aux Perdrix" is a quasimonopole (99%).

Built in the 17th century, **Château de Chamirey** overlooks the vineyards of Mercurey in Côte Chalonnaise. There are 92 acres of which 37 are classified Premiers Crus. There are 67 acres planted with Pinot Noir and 25 Chardonnay.

Under the name **Le Renard** is sold a limited number of wines selected from other top Burgundy estates by the Devillard's family.

CHÂTEAU DE CHAMIREY

Historic estate owned by the Devillard family in the Côte Chalonnaise. 37 hectares of Mercurey of which 15 hectares are planted in 6 Premiers Crus.

DOMAINE DE LA FERTÉ

Named after the Cistercian abbey de La Ferté, founded in 1113. Just 3 hectares of Givry.

DOMAINE DES PERDRIX

A benchmark estate, appreciated by the best sommeliers in the world. 15 hectares in the heart of the Côte de Nuits, of which the quasi-monopole Nuits-Saint-Georges Premier Cru «Aux Perdrix» and the Echezeaux Grand Cru

DOMAINE DE LA GARENNE

The union with the Devillard family from Mercurey, through the marriage of Pauline Beaumont and Amaury Devillard, has joined one of the best sites of the Maconnais region with one the most talented burgundy producer.
