
## TRES SABORES

## RUTHERFORD, NAPA








Tres Sabores means "Three Flavors" in Spanish, and in each wine, you'll find three equally savory, yet distinct tastes: the Terroir, or flavor embodied by the unique location of the ranch; the Vine, or distinct character of the grape variety; and the Artisan, or winemaker's personal contribution of style and intuition. When appropriately balanced, these flavors result in wines with intense, yet delicate aromas and a structure that supports both long-term aging and immediate enjoyment.



As stewards of the land, Tres Sabores is devoted to exploring the character of the grapes and producing wines that truly reflect the "voice" of the vineyard.



A whole host of animal friends contribute to the Tres Sabores operation in their own special way. The Tres Sabores sheep: Lucy (In the Sky with Diamonds), Didgeri and her son, 'doo', Decca and her daughter Nickeletta, Quincy, and "Simple Ed" are essential to the self-sustaining biodynamic vineyard system. Over the course of the season, our animals help mow, weed and contribute to a balanced compost pile.

There's nary a snail in the garden, a tick on a sheep, or a fly in the corral, thanks to their intrepid 'search out and eat' demeanor.
