Christian Collovray and Jean-Luc Terrier have known each other since childhood and have shared the same passion for the vine and the wine. Their links strengthened when they got married with two sisters, Brigitte and Florence. They are from a winemaker family but their father died when they were teenagers. With the four of them, they imagine the birth of a domain around the vines which the father of Christian owned in Davayé. Christian Collovray went into business in 1985. Jean-Luc Terrier joined him the year after.

The cultivated vines by the Domaine des Deux Roches are spread around the village of Davayé in neighboring Prissé, Vergisson, Pierreclos, Charnay-lès-Mâcon and Chardonnay.

The uneven relief of the vineyards is dominated by the limestone spurs of Solutré and Vergisson (Deux Roches), remains of the pre-historic time, and by the hill, though rounder but as high, the Pouilly Mount which reaches 485 meters.

The white wines from the Chardonnay grape dominate and blossom on stony and quite warm terroirs which are particularly favorable to them. Benefiting from the geological richness of the clay-limestone soils, they enjoy a good exposure and a rather mild climate, combining minerality and roundness.

Christian takes care of the vines while Jean-Luc manages the cellar and the commercial part. Julien Collovray, the son of Christian, joined the team in 2008 after training (winegrowing, oenology, law and economics) and fulfilling experiences: one year on a domain in Virginia (USA) as well as a few work experiences in France. Today, he is the connection between the purely winegrowing part and the marketing development of the house. He is also in charge of a few hectares in organic conversion.



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
