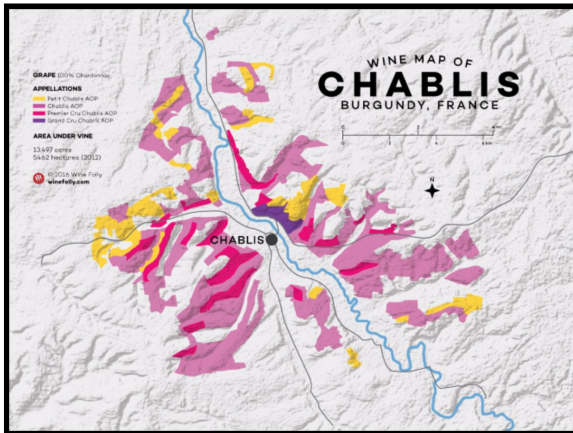

Tradition is important to the Servin family, which because of its long history in Chablis, owns some great parcels, the village parcel, les Pargues, formerly being a Premier Cru. François, however, while appreciating the great tradition, has taken big steps to bring this Domaine into the forefront of Chablis.—Peter Weygandt



As far back as the 16th century, the monks of Saint Martin cited the Servin family as vineyard owners in Chablis. Since then, successive generations have perpetuated the family's tradition and ever-evolving expertise as vineyard workers, coopers and winemakers.

Domaine Servin's 35 hectares of vineyards are situated within the boundaries of the village of Chablis, lying solely on Kimmeridgian limestone soils, which gives the wines their incomparable minerality. The majority of the vineyards are over 40 years old. The different rootstocks of these non-cloned Chardonnay plants produce a unique style of Chablis, combining concentrated flavours and intense aromas. Our guarantee of excellence.



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
