


CHATEAU DOMEYNE

SAINT-ESTÈPHE



The vineyard of Château Dômeayne is located on a beautiful hill of big gravels and it surrounds the vineyard of Château Calon-Ségur. The property confirmed in 2003 its ranking of the 1932 Cru Bourgeois and collects good scores every year. Excellent facilities allow the winemaking of a wine full of nuances and personality. In 2006, Château Dômeayne was bought by Claire Villars Lurton, owner of Château Haut-Bages Liberal and Château Ferrière, 5th Classified Growth of Pauillac and 3rd Classified Growth of Margaux, and her husband Gonzague Lurton, owner of Château Durfort Vivens, 2nd Classified Growth of Margaux. They put all their know-how to lift this wine among the best in the classification of Saint Estèphe.

The vineyard is planted on ridges and plateaus particularly serious drained that are very characteristic of the best terroirs of Saint-Estèphe. This land is also marked by a basement made of clay and limestone that gives the wine its particularity.

2016 VINTAGE

Manual harvest. Main sorting on the plant and final sorting on table. Winemaking traditional Bordeaux Style. In stainless steel and

thermo-regulated vats. Making in vats during 18 to 24 days. Oak barrel ageing (with 20% new) during 12 months.
